Acting in accordance with Louisiana Constitution, Article V, Section 1 and the inherent power of this Court as well as guidance from Jefferson Parish, the Continuity of Operations Plan of the Jefferson Parish Juvenile Court, and considering the emergency situation created by severe weather and other safety risks for the public and court staff as a result of the forecasted weather system moving through the metro area, the Chief Judge, acting on behalf of the Judges of Jefferson Parish Juvenile Court **HEREBY ORDERS THAT:**

The Juvenile Court for the Parish of Jefferson, State of Louisiana shall close at 11:30 a.m. on Monday, January 8, 2024, and will reopen Tuesday, January 9, 2024.
