January 21, 2025 – Severe Weather Closure

Acting in accordance with Louisiana Constitution Article V, Section 1; LSA R.S. 1:55; and the Continuity of Operations Plan of the 24<sup>th</sup> Judicial District Court; and considering that the Louisiana Commissioner of Administration has closed all state offices on Tuesday, January 21, 2025, and that the Jefferson Parish President has plans to close all Jefferson Parish offices; and further considering the potential for extreme weather and hazardous conditions due to forecasted below-freezing temperatures and precipitation,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

The 24<sup>th</sup> Judicial District Court shall be closed on Tuesday, January 21, 2025, and January 21, 2025 is declared to be a legal holiday pursuant to LSA R.S. 1:55.
