January 22, 2025 – Severe Weather Closure

Acting in accordance with Louisiana Constitution Article V, Section 1; LSA R.S. 1:55; and the Continuity of Operations Plan of the 24th Judicial District Court; and considering that Governor Jeff Landry has declared a State of Emergency and that Jefferson Parish plans to close all Jefferson Parish offices due to forecasted extreme winter weather and related hazardous road conditions,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

The 24th Judicial District Court shall be closed on Wednesday, January 22, 2025, and January 22, 2025 is declared to be a legal holiday pursuant to LSA R.S. 1:55.
