ORDER

Acting under the authority of Article V, Sections 1 and 5 of the Louisiana Constitution of 1974, and the inherent power of this Court, and considering the state of emergency declared statewide by Governor Jeff Landry in advance of inclement winter weather in Executive Order Number JML 26-006 on January 22, 2026, and the concomitant closure of all state offices on Monday, January 26, 2026,

It is HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

The Louisiana Supreme Court Offices and the Supreme Court Clerk of Court's office will be closed on Monday, January 26, 2026. All filings statewide due on Monday, January 26, 2026, shall be deemed timely filed if filed on or before Tuesday, January 27, 2026.
