IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that "Hurricane Ida Claims" allotted to Division I shall not be subject to the special master provisions of the Standing Case Management Order Regarding Certain Property Damages Suits Arising from Hurricane Ida, but shall proceed before the District Judge;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that any party to a "Hurricane Ida Claim" who wishes to opt-in to special master provisions of the Standing Case Management Order Regarding Certain Property Damages Suits Arising from Hurricane Ida may file with the District Judge either a consent motion to opt-in signed by all counsel, or, if not by consent, a motion to opt-in which shall be set for contradictory hearing and may be granted for good cause shown.
